- **Sightseeing tour of the city of Cairo.** Today Cairo is the largest city in Africa and the capital

of Egypt. This is one of the most populated cities on the planet: over 20 mln people live here. Cairo can be called a “city of contrasts” due to the unique combination of modern and ancient traditions. Here majestic skyscrapers and office buildings are organically neighboring mosques and mausoleums, whose age counts more than hundreds of years.

The Old Town attracts a great attention of tourists. This is the oldest part of Cairo and the heart of the Coptic Christian Community. There is the Mosque of Amr Ibn al-As – the first mosque of the city. Unfortunately, only Muslims can attend it. However, there are many other mosques and monasteries always ready to accept travelers. You can also visit Coptic Museum. One of the major attractions of the area is Church of the Saint Virgin Mary which is also called “The Hanging church”.

- **Excursion to Giza.** A complex of the historical monuments located in one of the suburbs of Cairo – Pyramids of Giza. These Pyramids is a target for the majority of tourists. The most famous of the Pyramids is Cheops Pyramid which is considered the ancient tomb of the Fourth Dynasty Egyptian Pharaoh Khufu. The smallest pyramid is called Pyramid of Mykerin. Dashur Pyramids are less popular amongst tourists, located 30 km away from Cairo. There is only Red Pyramid is opened for visitors, where excursions are regularly held.

- **Transfer to Alexandria.**

Alexandria is a port city of Egypt located on the North coast of the Mediterranean Sea. In the Epoque of Hellenism, Alexandria was famous for the Lighthouse, one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. Alexandria was also known for its Bibliotheca. Apart of that tourists are also attracted by the monuments of Greco-Roman period of the Egyptian history, ancient cafes, sandy beaches and Citadel of Qaitbay built in the XV century.

- Dinner. Overnight at the Hotel.







### **Day 5, 28.01.20**

- 8am transportation to Bibliotheca Alexandrina – one of the largest libraries of the ancient world which was probably founded by the initiative of the King Ptolemy I Soter. The exemplar for creation of the Alexandrian Library as state scientific and educational institution were gatherings at schools of Plato and Aristotle who reflected the time when Plato transferred the school from the grove of Academe to his own house, where Museyon (Temple of Muses) was founded. Later Theofast, student of Aristotle,

built special auditoriums and building of library for his peripatetic school.

- 8.30am – 4.15pm – annual forum of the Ukrainian School of Archetypes in Bibliotheca Alexandrina with the following events:

- **Excursion in the Bibliotheca Alexandrina and photo session near bas-relief of Lesia Ukrainka.**

- **Sightseeing tour of Alexandria.**
- Dinner and night transfer to Sharm-El-Sheikh.
