Dear friends, colleagues!

June 26, 2023 Ukrainian School of Archetypes (USA) of the Ukrainian Technological Academy on behalf of the international organizing committee of TMS-2023 invites teachers and students of educational-professional, educational-scientific programs of archetypal issues of public administration, archetypal social institutions and everyday life to participate in annual international events of USA TMS-2023:

- XIV theoretical and methodological seminar in memory of Oleg Amosov,
- XI competition of young scientists (MKMN-2023) in memory of Olga Balakireva,

which will be held online on the topic: “**Archetypal and public administration: delinquency as a manifestation of the conscious and unconscious during the war and in the post-war period**”.

The program framework of TMS-2023 will traditionally be determined by the scientific and research issues of public administration, within which it is proposed to consider the conscious (rational) and unconscious (archetypal) nature of delinquency as a psychological phenomenon of deviant behavior.

The goal of TMS-2023 is to unite the interdisciplinary efforts of representatives of social and humanitarian knowledge around the solution of theoretical and practical problems of public administration, social institutions and the postmodern present on the basis of archetypal methodology.

Within the specified framework, the following **TMS-2023 tasks** are proposed

1. *To explain* the causes of mass war crimes by Russian armed forces in the Russian-Ukrainian war (in the cities of Bucha, Irpin, Gostomel, Mariupol, Izyum, etc.) and predict possible manifestations of delinquency in the post-war period.

2. *To justify* delinquency, based on the understanding that it is a system of actions that have deviations from the generally accepted or supposedly permissible norm, whether it is the norm of mental health, law, culture or morality.

3. *Consider* mass delinquent behavior in the context of social transformation processes as a consequence of the blurring of social norms (anomy) or the destruction of relationships between subsystems of society (politics, economy, culture), which implies the presence of overt or hidden social psychopathology.

4. *To investigate* the phenomenon of delinquency as a form of antisocial behavior that violates certain social and cultural norms, especially legal ones. If such excesses are relatively minor, they are classified as a misdemeanor, and if they are serious and punishable by law, they are classified as a crime. Accordingly, they talk about delinquent (illegal) and criminal (criminal) behavior.

These and other related problematic issues will determine the space for understanding the topic of TMS-2023.

The organizers hope that, in addition to the literature on delinquency and deviance, the ideas of Carl Jung, Gilbert Durand and their followers will serve to achieve the goals and objectives of TMS-2023. In addition, the results of empirical studies of the Ukrainian school of archetypes, which are provided by the monitoring of societal (general system) changes: Ukraine (1992-2022), the Russian Federation (2010-2011), Belarus (2010-2013), Austria (2022) will be extremely valuable. The specified empirical material will be sent together with the information letter.

Master's students, post-graduate students, PhD candidates and candidates of sciences under the age of 35 from all vocational and scientific-educational specialties are invited to participate in IKYS-2023.

The international competition commission of experts from Kazakhstan, Poland, Ukraine, France will determine the best works of contestants, which will be awarded with incentive cash prizes: 1st prize – €200; 2nd prize – €150; 3rd prize – €100.
